Immigration

- After coming to Romania on the basis of the long-stay visa for study purposes, foreigners must request the extension of the right of residence for study purposes, until the expiration of the right of residence provided in the visa sticker.
- Foreigners with the right of temporary residence for studies can work on the Romanian territory to complete their means of subsistence
 - without notice of employment
 - only with individual part-time employment contract with a maximum working time of 4 hours per day





- The right of temporary residence for studies may be extended by 9 months after graduation
 - for a job search and employment formalities, or
 - in order to open a business, with the presentation of documents certifying the completion of studies



General Inspectorate for **Immigration**



- After completing their studies, foreigners holding a temporary right of residence for studies may request an extension of the right of residence for work purposes.
 - without the obligation to obtain a long-stay visa for employment
 - with the condition to present:
 - a copy of the employment notice;
 - the individual full-time employment contract, registered in the general register of employees, from which it results that the salary is at least at the level of the minimum gross basic salary per country guaranteed in payment;
- In the case of highly skilled workers, the salary must be at least twice the average gross earnings.
